Roblox

Many of you may already be aware of Roblox, an online gaming platform that is very popular with children. Roblox allows users to play games created by others and to design their own games. While it can be fun and creative, it also allows children to chat and play online with others and includes options to spend real money.

- Talking to people they do not know
- Seeing language or content that may not be suitable
- Spending money within the game
- Spending too much time online

- Monitor their child's online activity and screen time
- Talk to their child about staying safe online
- Report any concerns on Roblox by using the in-game **"Report Abuse"** feature (accessible by clicking the Roblox icon in the top left of the screen)
