<p>Our Learning Quest:</p> <p>What are the impacts of conflict?</p> 	<p>Find out about the correct measurements for rationing in World War 2. Write your own recipes, in a ration book for the Year 6 teachers.</p> <p><i>Remember to scale up or down for the correct amounts. (No waste during the war!)</i></p> <p>Or</p> <p>Create a Bar Graph show key statistics from the war. E.g. Number of soldiers in each army, casualties.</p>	<p>Write a diary entry of an evacuee.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Write a newspaper report on a key event such as the Blitz or D-DAY.</p>	<p>Debate: was Britain right to evacuate children during the war?</p> <p>Discuss with someone at home and note key arguments.</p>	<p>Create your own air raid shelter.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Design a propaganda poster encouraging people to support the war effort.</p>	<p>Teach an adult about the role of women during World War 2. Decide whether the war could have been won without them.</p> <p>And</p> <p>Recreate a historical speech and perform it to your family.</p>	<p>Visit a cenotaph in the local area.</p> <p>Notice what is written on it? How does it make you feel?</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Visit a museum and note down what you have learnt.</p>	<p>Investigate how Alan Turing cracked The Enigma Code. Try and write some coded messages.</p>	<p>Watch these clips on various WW2 topics and make notes.</p>  <p>And</p> <p>Watch Ethel and Ernest on BBC iPlayer (PG) with a family member.</p>
