Find the difference in height between Ben Nevis and these European peaks:</p> <p>Mont Blanc (France/Italy): 4,809m</p> <p>Mount Etna (Italy): 3,357m</p> <p>Mount Olympus (Greece): 2,917m</p>	<p>Write a short, persuasive letter to the Headteacher proposing a school trip to a European city. Your pitch must include:</p> <p>Two human features</p> <p>One physical feature</p>	<p>Interview a family member about Europe. Ask:</p> <p>Which European country have they visited (or would most like to visit) and why?</p> <p>What is one thing that is different there compared to England?</p>	<p>Build a 3D model of a famous European landmark (e.g., the Eiffel Tower or the Colosseum) using clean household recycling. Bring it in for our classroom exhibition.</p>	<p>Research a European country and find three fascinating facts. Teach these facts to someone at home, then quiz them 5 minutes later. Get them to sign your book to prove they passed!</p>	<p>Walk down a local high street with an adult. Look for clues connecting it to Europe.</p> <p>-Languages: Shop signs written in European alphabets</p> <p>-Food: Cafes, pizzerias, or grocers selling European food.</p> <p>-Flags: National flags in shop windows.</p>	<p>Check your kitchen cupboards or a local shop. Find three food items imported from Europe. Draw a quick table showing:</p> <p>-The food item</p> <p>-The country it came from</p> <p>-A small drawing of that country's flag.</p>	<p>Use Google Earth or watch a video clip online of Mount Etna in Italy.
