Our Local Area 	Calculate the distances between your house and key places in your local area. For example, a local park, your school or the local shopping area.	Write a letter to your local MP telling them something you would like to see change in your local area.	Talk with an adult about your favourite local place. Do you agree? Explain your different opinions. - I agree with you because... - I have a different opinion because... - I prefer...because...	Create a model of a part of your local area. You could use cardboard, Lego, junk modelling or other recycled materials. Be creative and have fun with it.	Become a geographer and teach someone in your family about the difference between <i>human and physical</i> features.	Visit the Firs Farm Wetlands or Forty Hall. Go for a walk around the area and identify 10 geographical features. You can take photos, draw or write a list of these features.	Investigate the different types of land use in the local area. For example, use these questions to help you: <i>How much land is used for housing, shops, transport, recreation (sports facilities, cinemas etc.,) education or green space?</i>	Watch the videos and read the information about maps and keys. Remember to document at least three things that you have learned.
