Hazelbury Learning Quest

History

- Children will be studying the past society of Ancient Greece using a range of resources to look closely at its social, ethnic, cultural and religious diversity.
- Understand that no single piece of evidence will give the full answer to the past.
- Research the history of the Olympic games, and make comparisons to the modern day Olympic Games.

Geography

Complete a range of fieldwork to observe, measure and record the human and physical features at the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park.

Art/D&T

- Design and create a Greek Sandal.
