Dear parents,

As you are probably aware the Government is updating their advice about Covid-19 every day.

As a result, advice about self-isolation has changed since my last letter. The latest guidance now states that, if one person in any household has a persistent cough or fever, everyone living there must stay at home for 14 days.

That means that any children who are in isolation because they or a member of the household are experiencing any of the symptoms above, must remain off school for 14 days.

Please continue to contact the school if your child needs to go into self-isolation. The attendance will be authorised provided you contact the school to confirm the reason for absence.

Thank you for your patience and co-operation with this very tricky and ever-changing situation. We will continue to update you with any changes to Government policy that will affect our procedures at school.

In the meantime, I want to reassure you that we are continuing to do all we can to minimise the risk to children by following all the advice from Public Health.
