Dear Parents,

We hope you and your families are all keeping safe and well during these difficult times. As mentioned in my previous letter we are constantly reviewing our support for your child's home learning and next week we will be introducing the online learning platform 'Seesaw' for years 3,2 and 1.

Seesaw, is an on-line learning platform accessible on any device, which the children have already used in school. This will enable your child's teacher to give them weekly feedback. Each week your child's teacher will set 'assignments' on Seesaw (just like the home learning packs) for your child to complete as best they can, given the vast range of circumstances we are all working in. Some of the tasks may be completed online and some may be completed in their exercise book. Teachers will make at least one comment a week on children's work. Once your child's year group begins to use Seesaw, if you have any problems with access or use, then please email homelearning@hazelburyprimaryelt.org and we will respond as soon as we can (please do not use Seesaw to communicate with us).

Over the next few days, your child will be given a code to access Seesaw. Your child's link and code will be text to your phone. All of the children should be familiar with seesaw as they have used this in school however if you have any queries regarding this please direct them to the email address above. There is also further guidance below on how your child can set this up.

We look forward to launching this new way of working and will keep it under review as we seek to explore manageable, safe and secure ways of developing closer communication between us.

We will continue to make alternative arrangements for those of you who have limited or no access to the internet or electronic devices. Home learning packs will still be available on the school website and you can still request for them to be printed and collected from outside the school office.



Seesaw Guide




Download seesaw class app. Seesaw can also be accessed on any device that has access to the internet.



Click I am a student.




You will then see this screen type your child's code in this box.




Journal

This is where you will be able to see work that has been set.




Inbox

This is where you can see a message from your teacher.


There are two options for children when presenting their work. They can write onto the assignment. Or they can create their work separately and upload a photo or video.

To add to assignment




Click add response

For adding your own work or image.




Choose what you are uploading.
