What will your child be learning about this half term?

In English we will be reading *Clean Up* by Nathan Bryon, *Red Alert* by Catherine Barr and *The Great Explorer* by Chris Judge. We will be writing in different genres including a recount, information text, fact-file and a letter. We will be focusing on learning the following grammar rules: using the past tense correctly, co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and adding commas to a list.

In Maths we will be focusing on finding number bonds to 10, 20 and 100, adding and subtracting two-digit numbers and ones, identifying multiplication and division facts for the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables and recognising and completing patterns and number sequences.

Our topic in science is living things and their habitats. They will learn how animals adapt to suit their habitat and relate this to their understanding of extinction. Pupils will also gain knowledge of how animals obtain food from their habitats and know the impact of the destruction of these habitats.

Our learning quest this half term is 'Can we stop extinction?' We will be focusing on learning skills in geography such as asking and answering geographical questions, using basic geographical vocabulary and using aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic physical features.

In art we will be learning use sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination, making links to the work of Lym Moreno.

In RE we will be exploring the theme of 'Light and Dark' by looking at stories from different religions including Christianity, Hinduism and Judaism.
