# Reception News Summer One



Thank you to everyone who has updated their 'All About Me' section on Tapestry and uploaded photos from your spring holidays! It has been lovely to see the fun that was had by everyone!

This half term our topic will be 'Where do animals live?' We will be learning all abouts animals and the different environments they live in, and looking at our planet and how to look after it in order to ensure we are protecting our wildlife. This will help the children begin to develop their geographical awareness, they will begin to use maps to gain an understanding of the world we live in, and explore the continents and countries that different animals originate from. They will get to have a first-hand experience of animals during our educational visit to the zoo this half-term!

The children will also have the opportunity to learn about other cultures as we will learn about Ramadan and how it is celebrated. We will continue with our learning in the outdoor learning garden so please ensure children have clothing that is appropriate for the weather, e.g. wet suits.

# **Celebrating Achievements**

The children made fantastic progress last half-term. They developed their mathematical vocabulary in many different contexts, engaging in different practical activities, such as measuring how tall they were. They developed scientific language during science week when they participated in a variety of experiements. This included learning about friction, discovering what materials allow cars to travel faster down the ramps, and creating their own potions. They learnt about healthy and unhealthy food, made their own healthy pizzas, and enjoyed "baking" in the mud kitchen.









### Why Not Try This at Home?!

To continue with the topic at home you may like to visit the farm or the aquarium to see some other animals in their different habitats. A visit to the library might be fun, and reading some non-fiction books to find out some more information about different animals and their habitats. Talk about litter and how to keep their environment clean – you could set up a small recycling corner to support this at home, e.g. a box for them to put paper in to put in the recycling bin, etc.

## Top Tips for Talking:

**Be careful with questions:** when adults use comments and prompts rather than questions, children join in and talk a lot more.

**Get their attention:** when children are absorbed in another activity, it can be hard to listen. Say their name first to get their attention and make sure they are listening.
