Dear Parents,

We are planning to take our classes to the Mountfitchet Castle and Norman Village, during April and May. Mountfitchet is an early age Roman, Saxon and Viking fort. This is a living history, hands-on and interactive experience to support our learning about the Anglo Saxons and Vikings in history. Pupils will be able to explore the Castle and roam through the village hidden behind the castle walls, wander in and out of the many houses and view the scenes, smell the log fires burning and experience the ambience of an ancient bygone lifestyle.

We will be leaving school at 9.15am to travel by minibus and will return to school by 3:15pm. Please ensure your child is in school at 8:40am so we can depart promptly.

Your child will need a packed lunch, however as all children are entitled to Universal Free School meals the school can provide a packed lunch. If you would like to order a packed lunch for your child for the day, please complete the Google form by **Monday 14th April**.
